Title

Golden rules for feeding and watering birds in winter

Season

The end of autumn, beginning of winter

Time

20 to 25 minutes

Target groups

Elderly
Children from 8 years

Objectives

To collect information from the group
To transmit standard knowledge about the topic and do it in a playful way

Resources

Two sheets of paper:

- A) a blank piece of paper (at least A3 size) with the title of the activity. Write "feeding" on one side of the paper at the top and "watering" on the other side, also at the top. In the bottom you can put some photos as illustration and stimulus for brainstorming. The groups will write in the blank part in the middle.
- B) the completed version of the previous paper (following the same structure).

Description

Groups of 4-6 persons (elderly persons and children mixed) are around a table. Give each team the blank sheet of paper.

They have to talk about what they know about the topic, and list their ideas. You can give them several minutes for this because it's certain that the elderly people will talk a lot and tell personal stories as well.

After a while give them the completed sheet of paper so that they can compare with what they have written.

After a few minutes we invite each team to tell everybody what extra ideas they had written which were not on the sheet.





They can keep the sheets, maybe put it/them on the classroom wall, and during whole winter check the activities.
