### Title

**Making wall paper with flowers and leaves**

### Season

All year round

### Time

60 to 90 minutes

### Target groups

Residents of care homes  
Children

### Objectives

Being creative with nature  
Old and young working together  
Decorating a table, long corridor or wall  
Creating a team spirit  
Enjoying being outdoors

### Resources

Collecting trays for nature treasures (1 per group)  
Long role wallpaper  
Double side adhesive tape  
Scissors

### Description

Organise the elderly and children into groups, with 2 to 3 children for each elderly person  
Take time to allow the elderly and children to get to know each other through asking questions, such as what's your name, in what year were you born, where do you live, what do you like in nature and so on?  
After each group has received a collecting tray, all groups go for a walk outdoors (in nature or a garden) to gather their natural 'treasures'  
Everyone stands or sits around a table with their natural 'treasures' and arranges these on the wallpaper





Give a preliminary lesson to children in the classroom on how to push people in a wheelchair safely and comfortably.

Cut the wall paper to the desired height and length in advance

Fix the double-sided tape on one side on the wallpaper

Draw attention that all the leaves, flowers should be stuck well to the tape!

Also be careful with things that should not be stuck on the paper!
