### Title

**Where to throw our waste?  
(Recycling / 2)**

### Season

Any

### Time

10 to 15 minutes

### Target groups

Elderly  
Children from 8 years

### Objectives

To show new ways of recycling (selective waste collection)  
To create selective waste collection rules

### Resources

Sheet of paper with line drawings and name of the bins for different kinds of selective waste, and one column for "others" (1 sheet / table)  
Pens  
Coloured pencils or crayon or felt tip pens  
Cards with the name of different kinds of litter (several for each group) (1 set / table)

### Description

Groups of 4-6 persons (elderly people and children mixed) get 1 sheet of paper, a set of pens and pencils and 1 set of cards. Firstly they have to discuss which bin is which colour and then colour it. Afterward they have to find the right place to throw the different items of waste on the cards and put them under the correct bin.

When each group is ready, let's check it together! When they talk about the "others" group you can ask "Where should they be thrown exactly?", e.g. used oil, medicine, battery, etc.



The text must be written with letters big enough for elderly people with slight sight problems.
