### *Title*

**What is the taste like?**

### *Season*

Autumn, when apples are ripe

### *Time*

20 to 25 minutes

### *Target groups*

Elderly  
Children from 8 years

### *Objectives*

Collection of information about local varieties of fruit trees.  
Show how local varieties of fruits are different.  
Gather information from elderly people how fruit was grown and how harvest in autumn happened when they were young.  
Gather information from elderly people about fruit conservation, and home made dishes.

### *Resources*

Different varieties of apples or other fruit  
Plates  
Knives  
1 sheet with photos of different gardening activities, fruits, harvest, etc. on each table

### *Description*

In small groups of 4-6 persons elderly people and children cut the different varieties of apples and taste the differences between them.

With the help of the information sheet with photos and tasting the fruit they are invited to talk about how the fruit was grown and harvested in autumn when the elderly people were young. They can speak about fruit conservation and using fruit for home made dishes.
